

Cape Royal Golf Club Operations Update 3-20-2020

As we continue to be diligent and follow all guidelines set forth by the state, county, and federal orders, we must announce that effective tonight our restaurant, The Caloosa Club will be closed to on-site dining and beverage services. This executive order by Governor Ron Desantis was released this afternoon. I would like to provide you at this time with specific information on our operation, and how you can still enjoy the wonderful food, beverages, and services that we offer here at Cape Royal.

Guidelines and general information:

1. The Golf Course will remain open and we encourage you to enjoy the game of golf.
2. The Caloosa Club will be providing food To Go and for Delivery from the hours of 9 am to 6 pm. Our full menu will be available and Chef Mark has prepared special menu items in addition for you to pick up or to be delivered. Call 239-283-5522 Extension #2 for more information and to place your order.
3. There is no delivery charge for our playing golfers, or to Cape Royal Community residents. The last delivery time to residents will be at 5:45pm, and please allow 20 minutes for food preparation and 15 minutes for delivery.

5. **Alcohol is also available for purchase To Go or by Delivery.** Items will be served in sealed containers and it is a requirement that a food purchase accompanies your order. We are prohibited from selling alcohol-only purchases.

During this strange and uncertain time, we are diligently acting with care and restrain in our operations. The regulations directed to us by the CDC, FDBPR and our GGP Troon CRVS Action and Compliance Team are being followed. Our staff will remain at a safe distance from one another and customers, and groups and capacities will be limited to 10. The operations of our golf course will remain open and the changes you may experience will include removal of bunker rakes and ball washers for an example. You will notice Staff wearing gloves in all departments, and keeping a safe, yet reliable distance. We will be disinfecting all areas that you may come in contact with throughout the day and we will be managing the operation with awareness to social distancing. Effective March 20th, 2020 our hours of operations will be as follows:

- Golf Operations will be open from **7am to 4pm**.
- The last 18-hole tee time will be 2:00pm, and the last 9-hole tee time will be at 4pm.
- The driving range and all practice facilities will close at 6pm

- Bag Drop service will be available **7am to 6pm** as all carts will need to be back by 6pm.
- The Caloosa Club restaurant will be open for Take Out and Delivery from **9am to 6pm**.

As we set the standards for our “new normal” here at Cape Royal we encourage everyone to be diligent in your efforts of social awareness and safety. Martin Dempster of The Scotsman publication wrote a wonderful article that Golf Digest published. He says, *“To me, golf has to be one of the safest places anyone could be at the moment and, by the sounds of things, the medical experts are of the same opinion. “You’re not in contact with a whole lot of other people,” Dr Catherine Troisi, an infectious disease epidemiologist at the University of Texas Health Science Center at Houston told golfdigest.com.”*
